Dear Parents:

Listed below are the **Modern Languages and Math** courses that Rockhurst High School offers for dual enrollment credit with Rockhurst University (college credit taken during the high school years). Dr. Koleen Kolenc, Assistant Dean of Arts & Sciences at Rockhurst University, will register students on Friday, **September 19th** at Rockhurst High School. Students will register during their scheduled class time in the McGee Hall. For more information go to www.rockhurst.edu/accp.

Student Eligibility & Requirements:

- Students must have a minimum cumulative gpa of a **3.0**. Students whose gpa's range from 2.5 to 2.99 may register with permission from the instructor. Students who fall into this category must have their parents sign the parental permission form. The program is not open to freshmen.
- In order for RU to grant credit there is a five-student minimum in each class. In other words, if less than 5 students in the class choose to take the course, RU will not offer the course for credit. RHS however will not cancel the course.
- Students who enroll in a course through RU will have a transcript from the University. Institutions nationwide have varying policies on accepting dual enrollment credit; you are encouraged to discuss this with the institutions that your son is considering at this time.
- The tuition for 2017 is \$83 per credit hour. All first-time ACCP students pay a one-time matriculation fee of \$60. If a student paid this fee last year, they do not have to pay this year.
- **Students wishing to enroll in a course through RU must have a check, made payable to Rockhurst University, September 19th. The check must include the \$60 matriculation fee (if applicable) and one third of the total tuition for the semester.**
- **Please note, due to changes in credit card processing, Rockhurst cannot accept credit card payments at registration. If a student wishes to pay by credit card, they may call the Student Accounts Office (816-501-4683) approximately 2 weeks after registration and provide the credit card information. There will be a 2.5 % charge.**
