RE: Senior Expenses

Many have found the following useful for anticipating some of the expenses associated with the senior year. Other expenses may be incurred which are not listed below:

Athletics – Fees vary for varsity sports participation and refundable uniform or equipment deposits. Costs vary depending upon equipment and replacement cost.

Bookstore – Parents will purchase most textbooks online and pay an app/textbook fee for iPad apps and select books. Go to the “Academic” tab on the RHS website and then “Course Book List” for more details when schedules are sent later this summer.

Advanced Placement -The College Board Advanced Placement exams may cost \$100 or higher per exam. College Board sets the price per exam on a yearly basis. ACCP fees for college credit are, at this time \$83, *per credit hour* with a one time registration fee of \$60. Each class is listed as either a 3 or 4 hour course. (Fees are subject to change for the coming school year.)

Graduation – No fee for graduation, but related items may be purchased through Jostens.

Library – Lost books or periodicals. Replacement cost.

Senior Portraits – Seniors will be receiving information over the summer regarding Senior Portraits.

Prom - Dinner/Dance (per couple) – approximately \$130-\$150 (Expenses are subject to change.) Other expenses (photos, etc.) vary depending on choices made.

Tuxedo – Required attire for Prom and Graduation. A tuxedo may be purchased through a Men’s Warehouse discount arranged by the Parents’ Club. Information will be posted on the website for more information, but the anticipated cost for tux, shoes, shirt, jacket, pants, cummerbund, bow tie, and button/cuff links is approximately \$150-\$175.

Homecoming – Dance (per couple) approximately \$30. Other expenses vary depending on choices made.

All of the above costs are subject to change in the coming year. However, we do not expect any major changes.
